VISION

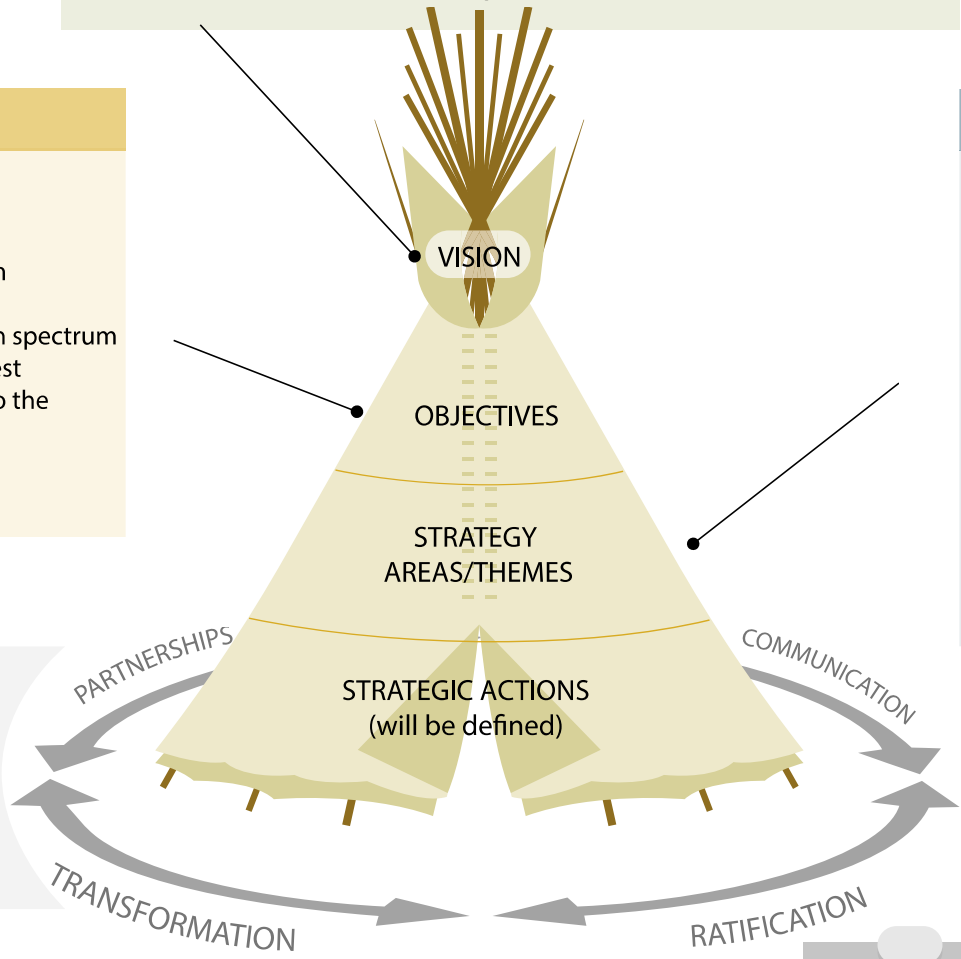

 - 12) Environment



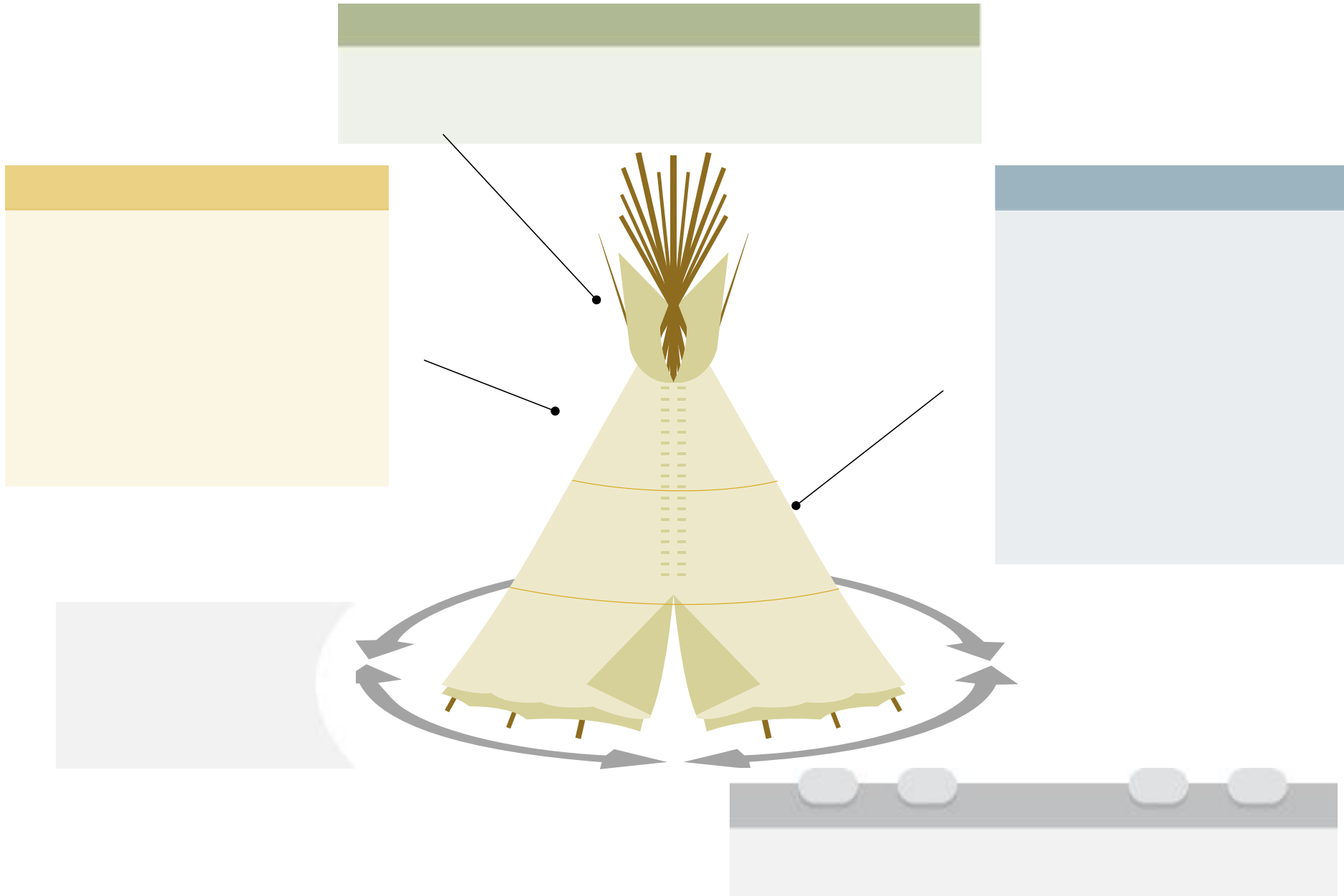
We will be guided by the following four principles and they will be interwoven into each step of the process:

- 4) Ratification

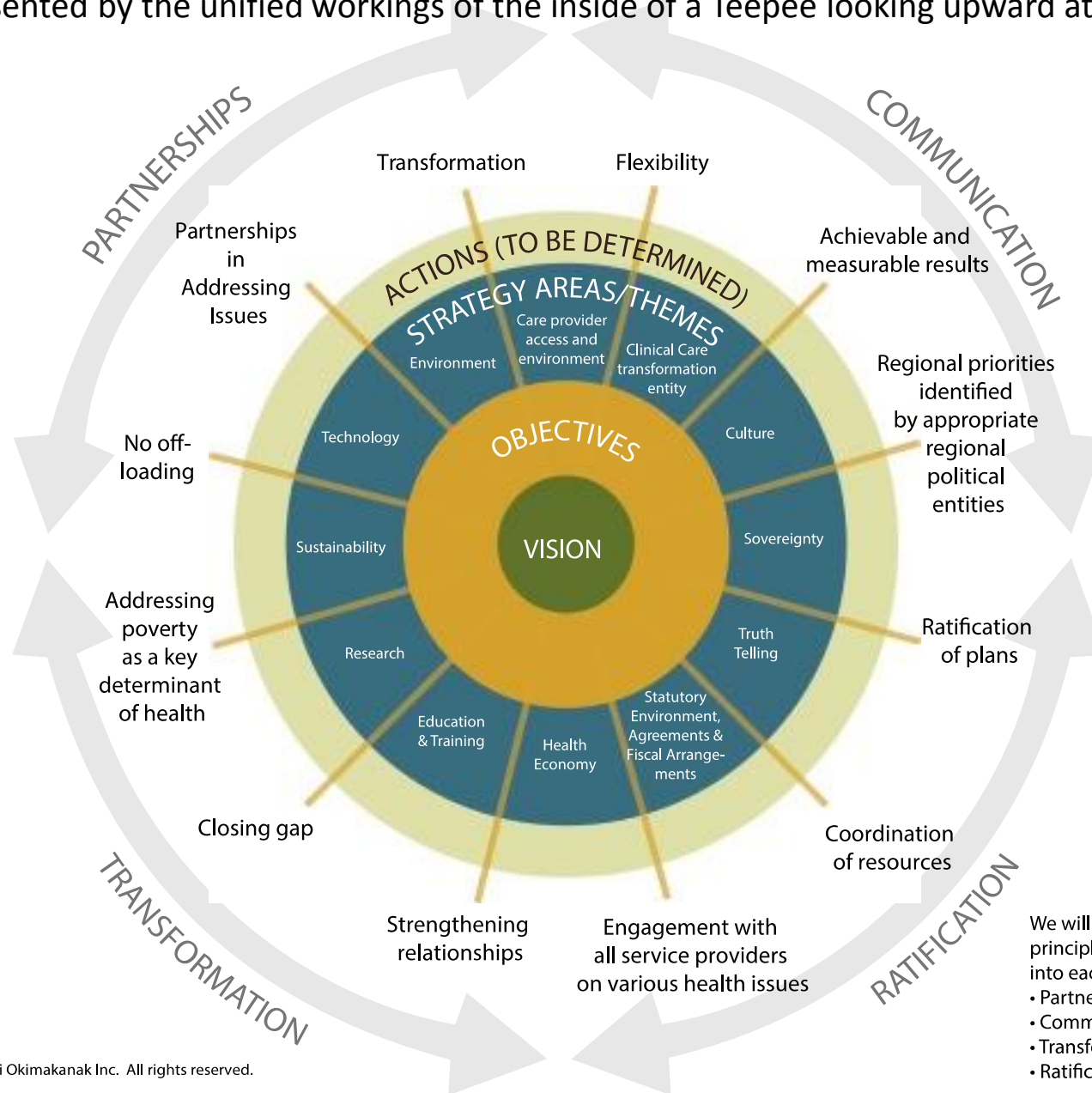
4 PILLARS

 1. Legislation 2. Governance 3. Service Delivery 4. Fiscal Policy

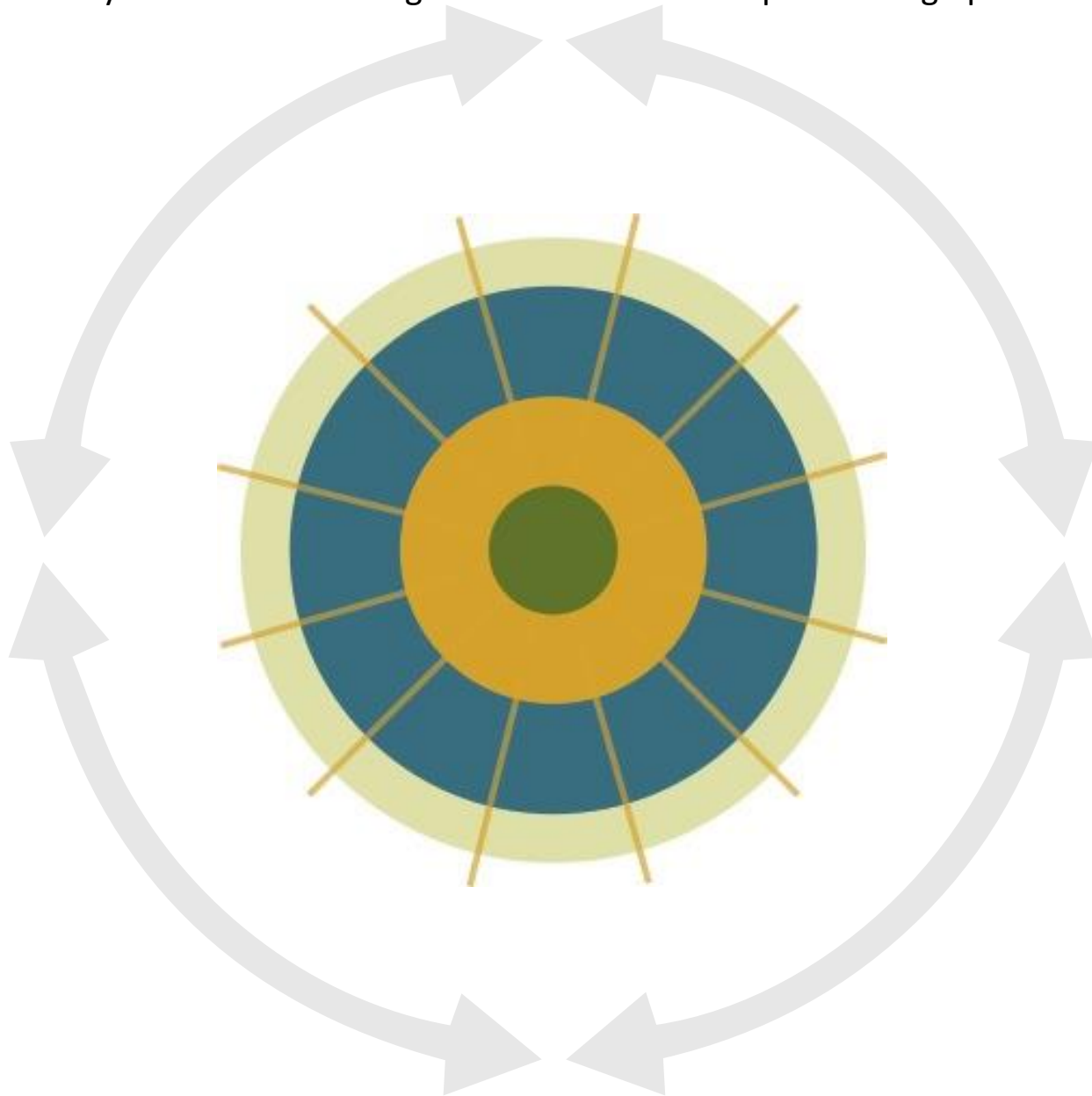
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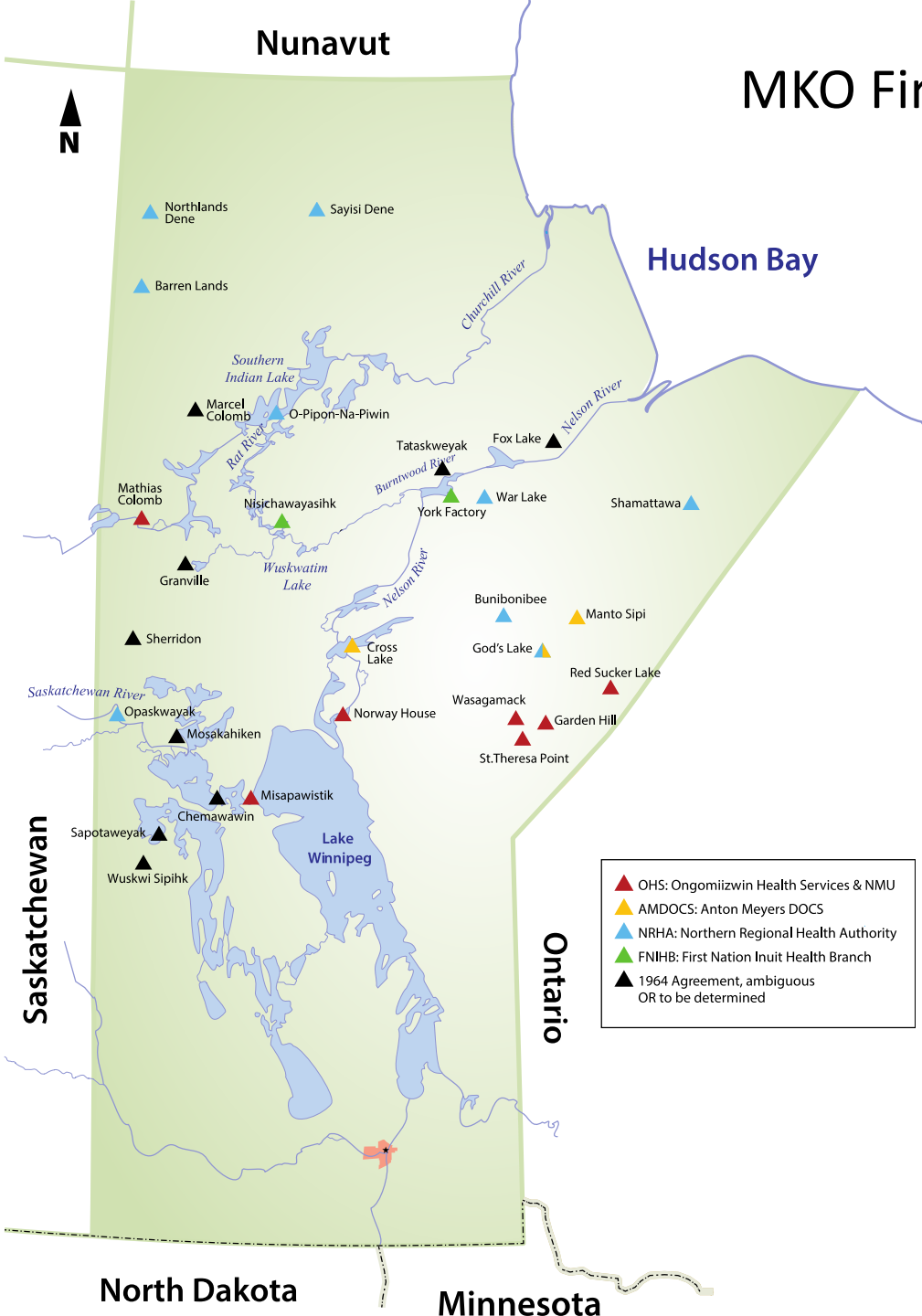
Understanding the CCT Structure and Process^(As represented by the unified workings of the inside of a Teepee looking upward at the poles)
