The instructor will teach newcomer adults in the Intensive English as a Second Language program funded by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada. The instructor is responsible for building effective student/instructor relationships, assessing students' goals and needs, providing classroom instruction based on student goals and needs, developing curriculum and materials focused on language skills necessary for the Canadian workplace, supervising and guiding students, using the Canadian Language Benchmarks document, evaluating student progress using the Portfolio Based Language Assessment and maintaining student attendance records.
