DUTIES

Red River College Polytechnic has an exciting opportunity for a registered nurse who no longer wants to work mandated overtime or shift work. RRC Polytech nurses work a regular Monday to Friday day shift.

Reporting to the Manager of Safety and Health Services, the Nurse works collaboratively within a team environment to provide excellent customer service to a diverse population of staff, faculty, and students. The Health Centre is a fast-paced department that requires nurses to be forward thinking and solution oriented. This position will rotate between Notre Dame and Exchange District Campuses and provide support to Regional Campuses. The Nurse is responsible to ensure that clinical records are kept in accordance with all legislated acts such as PHIA, FIPPA, etc.

A large part of the position is to administer immunizations to ensure that students are prepared to enter their work integrated learning placements. Nurses also coordinate the flu clinics that are offered to the college community.

The Health Centre provides a wide range of services such as mental health triage, assistance with medical care plans, WCB and Student Medical case management, managing the clinic, responding to on-campus medical incidents, and providing education on health related topics.

- Experience working within the field, including non-health care settings
