We are seeking a Project Architect to join our Supply Chain team. Under the general direction of the Planning & Design Lead, the Project Architect will represent Manitoba Hydro as a design manager for various facility-related capital projects. Will focus primarily on management of the planning and design phase but will extend to supporting contract administration during the construction phase. In addition, will provide subject matter expertise for architectural topics (for example, building code interpretation, envelope assessments) as required throughout the department and broader enterprise. This role will be an active contributor to Manitoba Hydro's continued development of a sustainable portfolio of facilities to support the core business.

Responsibilities:

- Lead and/or participate in the development and implementation of major capital projects, including needs assessment, procurement, and providing direction to the design and construction team.
- Develop Master Plans to guide long-term investments in corporate facilities for various regions.
- Provide Architectural subject matter expertise throughout the department as required. This includes conducting design reviews of consultant work for quality and providing guidance in building code interpretation.
- Support facility asset management strategy, working with colleagues in Planning & Design.
- Identify and vet capital renewal projects for coordination with other sections of Corporate Facilities.
- Responsible for procurement of consulting services necessary to support the asset management strategy.

Qualifications:

- Graduate degree in Architecture from a University of recognized standing.
- Registered with the Manitoba Association of Architects (MAA) or eligible for immediate registration.
- Minimum of five years of related experience, with a demonstrated ability in project management of facility construction projects.
- Strong grasp of computer skills, with an elevated level of proficiency in Office 365 tools. Expertise in project management software is considered an asset.
- Proven and demonstrated commitment to sustainability and building performance. Sustainability designations would be an asset.
- Must have a thorough demonstrated knowledge of facilities and grounds, including but not limited to, planning, design and construction together with a working knowledge of buildings and building systems including, structural, envelope, mechanical (HVAC), electrical, plumbing, well systems, voice & data communication and other systems related to security, safety and operations.
- Must have working knowledge of Federal and Provincial Codes and Standards, and Safety and Occupational Health Rules as they apply to the construction of buildings, grounds, and associated plants.
- Demonstrated ability in planning and directing multiple construction projects, including project management, cost control,

scheduling, and reporting. Post-secondary education in Project Management or PMP designation would be an asset.

- Experience with scheduling multiple work groups to achieve project goals, timelines, and budgets. Excellent verbal and written communication skills with the ability to liaise between clients, designers, contractors, and engineering experts at various levels,
- Experience in contract administration, specification, and report preparation.
- Demonstrated ability and experience in assembling scope of work and writing technical specs for large to small projects, implement and administer contractor service contracts.
- Mature judgment and proven ability to delivery assigned duties with minimal direction and supervision.
