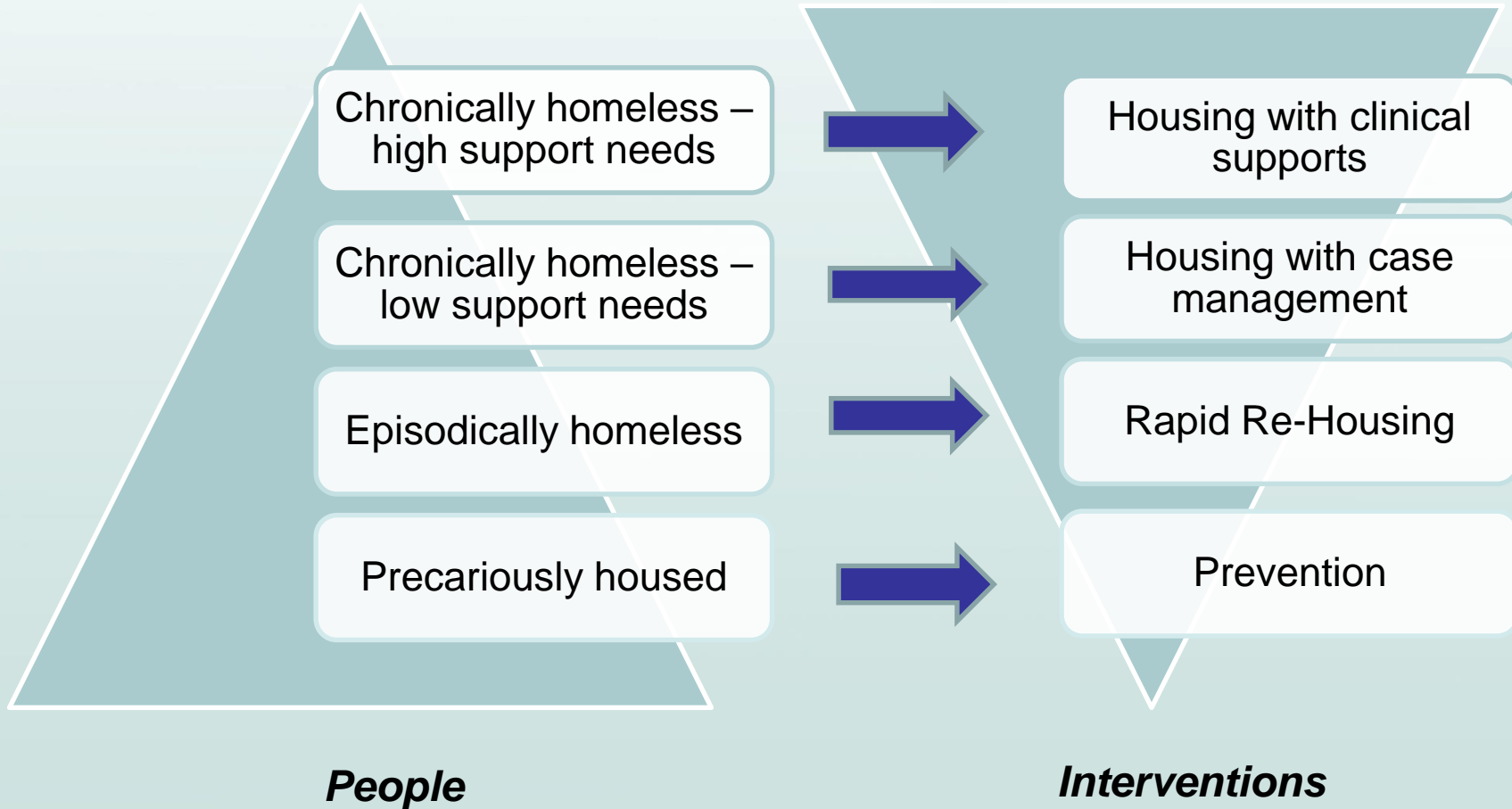
Underlying Approach
