Reporting to the Support Worker Supervisor and Support Worker Assistants. All service providers provide care and support to our children and the families that Awasis Agency of Northern Manitoba supports. Support Workers provide support and assistance to children and families. Homemaker/Parent Aide Services, assist parents in developing safe/healthy-parenting practices. Homemaker services may include assisting with house duties such as cleaning, laundry, cooking or shopping for the family. Respite Workers provide respite to parents and foster parents. Promotes, encourages and ensures safety of the client, remains responsive to the client's needs at all times. Service providers may escort client into community to attend community activity.

**Key Responsibilities:**

- Help prevent family breakdown
- Knowledge and ability to teach basic parenting skills and life skills to our children and families
- Working with families, providing support such as respite, parent-aide, home maker, etc.
- Transporting children to and from family visits, daycare, school, therapy appointments, etc.
- Demonstrate positive role modelling and positive behavior
- Working one on one to help meet that child's needs (obtaining ID's, appointments, resources, etc.)

**Qualifications:**

- Certified and or experience working as a Support Worker
- Strong documentation and writing skills
- Some knowledge and understanding of Child Welfare
- Demonstrated understanding and respect for Indigenous culture
- Ability to speak the Cree and/or Dene language is considered an asset
- Training in NVCI, ASSIST, CPR/First Aide

- Confidentiality environment with access to sensitive information
- Maintain a satisfactory Prior Contact Check, Child Abuse Registry Check, Criminal Record Check and Driver's Abstract
- Maintain a valid driver's license and have access to a vehicle
